40 DAYS OF PRAYER – WESTGATE 2024

Beginning Wednesday, February 21, we will enter into a **time of special prayer** over the next 40 days that will culminate on Easter Sunday, March 31. This time of prayer will serve to **focus us** on our spiritual renewal as individuals, as a church body and as a city. Scripture encourages us to come before the throne of God with confidence. The Hebrew writer says in **Hebrews 4:16**, "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." In this time of prayer, be encouraged to **go boldly before the throne** of grace and offer up our petitions.

You will see on the following pages that there are **Scripture references and specific intentions** for each day to focus your time of prayer. Please **read** the passages, **consider** those passages that you read, and then take time to **pray** for the specific intention of that day. Many of you have a robust prayer life already in place. If that is the case, please **add these specific intentions to your prayer time** you already have. We have picked 40 days of prayer because of the significance of that time period throughout the Bible.

Consider the following:

- · Rain fell for 40 days during the Flood
- Moses was on Mount Sinai with God for 40 days
- Israelite spies took 40 days to explore the Promised Land
- · Jonah warned Nineveh for 40 days
- · Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness after His baptism
- Jesus spent 40 days with the disciples after His resurrection

If you are new to prayer, here are a **few pointers** that will help you facilitate a strong prayer life. First, **assign a time** you are going to pray and get rid of all distractions during that time. Next, **have an idea** of how you want to structure your prayer. One easy template to use for prayer is the acronym A-C-T-S. **"A" is for Adoration**, which means praising God for His greatness. In Adoration, you proclaim your adoration for God as Creator and Redeemer. **"C" is for Confession**, which centers around having a contrite heart. We confess our sins before God and show our total reliance on Him. **"T" is for Thanksgiving**, and it is at this time we thank God for all He has done for us. **"S" is for Supplication**, and that centers on offering up our requests to God. This is the part of the prayer where we make our petitions known to God.

Hopefully, this 40-day period will **strengthen your walk with Jesus**. It is to Him, through Him and for Him that we live and offer ourselves as a living sacrifice.

Day 40 (3/31 – Easter Sunday): Thanksgiving to God for the resurrection of the dead and victory over death – Jn 20:1-9
